Rules for "I've Got A Picture"

Player A draws a card from a shuffled mini-deck consisting of one suit. She looks at her card.

Then A bets either \$1 or \$5. Player B can now concede the bet (i.e. A collects the amount bet from B) or double the bet.

If the bet is doubled, the card is then exposed and player A collects the doubled bet from B if the card is a Jack, Queen or King. If the card is A, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, then B collects the doubled amount from A.
